WHAT TO EXPECT IN EACH GATEWAY MATH COURSE

Math 120 (3 credits) with **Math 20** (2 credits) uses ALEKS for online homework and exams. Other aspects of the course may include in-person lectures and class activities dependent on the modality and projects that vary dependent on the instructor. Students are expected to spend 9-12 hours per week of work outside the classroom.

Math 124 (3 credits) with **Math 24** (2 credits) is similar to Math 126/26 but slightly less algebraically intensive and designed for students pursuing a Business degree. Students are expected to spend 12-15 hours per week of work outside the classroom.

Math 126 (3 credits) with **Math 26** (3 credits) is designed for student pursuing an AS transfer degree. Instructor may use WebAssign for homework. Students are expected to spend 15-20 hours per week of work outside the classroom.

WHAT TO EXPECT IN A COREQUISITE MATH COURSE

All three of these courses offer two formats: a standalone three credit format and additional 2-3 credits of corequisite support for those that require it. The corequisite format meets with an instructor twice a week with a focus on development of the specific prerequisite abilities that would be expected in the stand alone.
