Item 1: Life Cycle Replacement Plan

Item 2: New Application for Admission

Item 4: Other Items

- SWIVL is a video collaboration tool that a few departments have inquired about having. It is a moving an Ipad that streams and records instructors as they walk and lecture around the classroom.
- Complete wireless system needs an upgrade and will most likely happen in FY22. All wireless access points would have to be replaced and new cable would have to be ran.
- The Automotive and Diesel program at the Edison Campus could use more Smartboards. IT will inquire about potential funding. In the meantime boards that are not being used will be given to the Edison Campus.
- The Library catalog data base, Voyager, is going to be replaced with a new system called ALMA. UNR GBC WNC are all working together to migrate to ALMA. This will happen around late June.
