General Information

If a student is reclassified to resident student status, the reclassification shall become effective at the registration period immediately following the date the student receives notice of the reclassification decision.

There is a rebuttable presumption that a nonresident attending an institution of the NSHE is in the state of Nevada for the primary or sole purpose of obtaining an education. Therefore, a nonresident who enrolls in an institution of the System shall continue to be classified as a nonresident student throughout the student's enrolment, unless and until the student demonstrates that his or her previous residence has been abandoned and that the student is a Nevada resident. The student's reliance on non-Nevada sources for financial support constitutes inference of residence in another state.

A student applying for reclassification to resident status must submit objective documentary evidence to support the student's claim to Nevada residence. Determinations of residence shall be made on a case-by-case basis and the evidence presented shall be given the weight and sufficiency it deserves, after taking all available evidence into consideration.

Documentation Part II

The following documentation is required for a financially dependent person who has been a resident of Nevada for a period of at least twelve (12) continuous months immediately prior to the first day of the semester in which the student is applying for change of residency status.

A financially dependent person whose family or legal guardian is a non-Nevada resident cannot apply for reclassification to resident student status. Students who are financially dependent are defined as being declared on another person's Federal income tax return.

Because residence in a neighboring state other than Nevada is a continuing qualification for enrollment in the Good Neighbor, or WICH Western Undergraduate Exchange Programs at a NSHE institution, a student who was initially enrolled in a NSHE institution under one of these reduced-fee non-resident programs shall not normally be reclassified as a Nevada resident following matriculation. A non-resident student who subsequently disenrolls from the Good Neighbor, or WICHE Western Undergraduate Exchange Programs and pays full nonresident tuition for at least twelve (12) months may apply for reclassification to resident student status. An application for reclassification may also be submitted under the provisions of this section if the material facts of a student's residency or the parent's or legal guardian's residency have substantially changed following matriculation.

Documentation Part III

The following documentation is required for a financially independent person who has been a resident of Nevada for a period of at least twelve (12) continuous months immediately prior to the first day of the semester in which the student is applying for change of residency status.

These documents must show clear, convincing, and objective evidence of establishing ties to Nevada, and demonstrate financial independence by personally funding his/her own educational and living expenses.

PLEASE CHECK OFF AND SUBMIT DOCUMENTATION FROM ALL THREE OF THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

1. Proof of bona fide residence status in Nevada. No fewer than four (4) of the following pieces of objective evidence must be submitted with this application:

- Proof of ownership of a home in Nevada.
- Lease of living quarters in Nevada.
- Mortgage or rent receipts and utility receipts for the home or leased quarters.
- Nevada driver's license or Nevada identification card issued twelve (12) months prior to the date of application.
- Nevada vehicle registration issued twelve (12) months prior to the date of application.
- Nevada voter registration issued twelve (12) months prior to the date of application.

2. Proof of financial independence. One (1) of the following documents must be submitted with the application:

- A true and correct copy of the student's federal income tax return for the most recent tax year showing a Nevada address.
- If no tax return has been filed because of minimal or no taxable income, documented information concerning the receipt of such nontaxable income must be submitted.
- If the student is under age 24, a copy of the parent's or legal guardian's tax return for the most recent tax year must be submitted that indicates the student was not claimed as a dependent.

3. Proof of intent to remain in Nevada. No fewer than three (3) of the following pieces of objective evidence must be submitted with the application:

- Employment in Nevada for twelve (12) months immediately prior to the date of the application for reclassification.
- A license to conduct a business in Nevada.
- Admission to a licensed practicing profession in Nevada.
- Registration or payment of taxes or fees on a home, vehicle, mobile home, travel trailer, boat or any other item of personal property owned or used by the person, for which state registration or payment of a state tax or fee is required, for the twelve (12) month period immediately prior to the date on the application.
- A Nevada address listed on a selective service registration.
- Evidence of active savings and checking accounts in Nevada financial institutions for at least twelve (12) months immediately prior to the date of the application.
- Evidence of summer term enrollment at a NSHE institution.
- Voting or registering to vote in Nevada.
- Any other evidence that objectively documents intent to abandon residence in any other state and to establish a Nevada residence.

Declaration of Intent of Residency

I hereby declare that I have abandoned any domicile or residence in any state or commonwealth of the United States of America other than the State of Nevada and I further certify that I have established a bona fide domicile or residence in the State of Nevada with the intent of making Nevada my true, fixed and permanent home and place of habitation, having clearly abandoned my former domicile or residence and having no intent to make any other location outside the State of Nevada my home and habitation.

I further certify that I have been domiciled or a resident in the State of Nevada for at least twelve (12) months immediately prior to the date of my application for reclassification to resident student status and that, therefore, I have been physically present and residing in Nevada for that entire period of time, excluding temporary, short-term absences for business or pleasure.
