Payment Plan Information

- Students must owe a minimum of \$200 in fees to enroll in the plan
- Tuition/fees are divided into three equal payments
 - 1st payment is due on August 18, 2011
 - 2nd payment is due on September 18, 2011
 - 3rd payment is due on October 18, 2011
- There is **No Charge** for enrolling in this program
- **All late payments MAY be subject to enrollment cancellation**
 - **Payments must be paid by the date they are due or the student will be in danger of having their entire enrollment cancelled.**
- Important information about enrollment:
 - **Enroll in the payment plan first, and then make your payment.**
 - It is important that you DO NOT make a payment PRIOR to enrolling in a payment plan. The payment plan will NOT recognize your payment and at tuition/fees due date it would appear that you had not paid.

Student's Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Why do I need a payment plan?

A: The short answer is you MAY not need a payment plan but IF you do, we have one. This payment plan will help ease the financial burden that being in school brings because it will allow a student to pay their fees (that portion not covered by financial aid) in three equal installments.

Q: How do I sign up for the payment plan?

A: Log on to my.tmcc.edu

Scroll down to Finances on the General Page

Using the Drop Down box select "Enroll in Payment Plan"

You will go through a series of steps that will allow you to complete your payment plan enrollment.

Please note only the balance of the account (everything due (NOT including financial aid)) will be eligible for the payment plan and, only balances of \$200 or more.

Q: Will I be dropped from my classes?

A: If you do not pay, you may be removed from your classes. If you sign up for a payment plan and miss any of the three installment payments, you may be subject to enrollment cancellation. If you have anticipated aid, you will not be dropped.

Q: Is there a fee for the payment plan?

A: No. It is entirely free to sign up for this plan

Q: What if I miss making a payment?

A: If you miss ANY payment, you may be dropped from all of your classes.

Q: My financial aid does not cover my whole bill and the remainder is less than \$200. Can I still have a payment plan?

A: Yes. The payment plan will take into account all the fees on your account and does not subtract anticipated aid. Please remember that payment plans are eligible for those students who have an account balance of \$200 or greater. After your aid is applied, your installments will be adjusted to reflect the balance due.

Q: My financial aid is not available until after the payment deadline. Will I be dropped?

A: You may be dropped. You will need to either pay in full OR sign up for the payment plan and make the first payment. Provided your financial aid arrives within the next month all will be well. If it is late, you will be expected to make the second payment on your payment plan.
