## **TMCC Massage Students score significantly higher on national certification exams**

*Reno, Nev.*—Graduates of TMCC’s Massage Training Program scored higher on average than their counterparts across the state and the nation, according to the National Certification Board for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork’s Bi-annual School Pass Rate Report.

Students are tested on anatomy, physiology, kinesiology, pathology, massage and bodywork assessment and application, professional standards, ethics and business and legal practices. For those taking the National Exam for Therapeutic Massage, the TMCC students’ average pass rate hit 100 percent (the average for other Nevada massage students was 51.3 percent). For the National Exam for Massage and Bodywork, TMCC students’ average pass rate was 87.5 percent, considerably up from the statewide average of 60.8 percent.

TMCC’s Massage Training Certificate provides students with a background in sciences, business practices and diverse massage techniques, ranging from Swedish and Myofascial to Oriental and Sports modalities.
