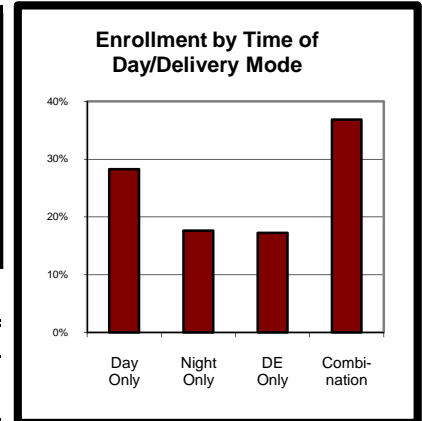

- State supported FTE and headcount in Spring 09 grew by 5.8% and 1.6%, respectively, over Spring 08.
- In Spring 09, 14% of TMCC students are co-enrolled at another institution.
- Distance education accounted for 25% of the FTE in Spring 09.

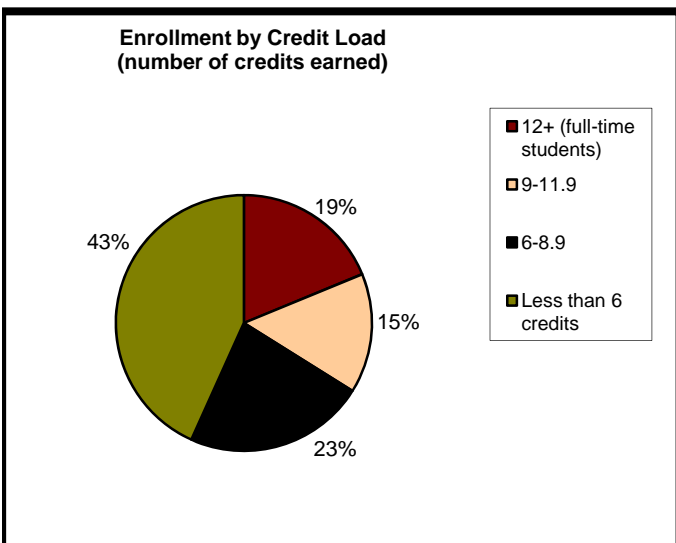

- In Spring 09, 25% of TMCC students are minorities, up from 24% in Spring 08.
- The percentage of students completing 12 or more credits in Spring 09 is up 3% from Spring 08 and up 6% from Spring 07.
- Approximately 20% of students are enrolled in 1 or more developmental course, which is about 1% more than the spring 08 and 3% more than spring 06 and spring 07. Developmental education accounts for 9% of the total FTE in Spring 09.
