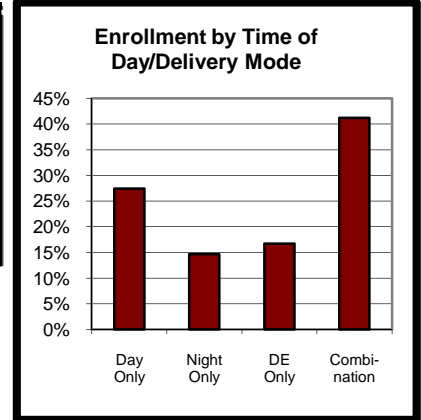

- In Spring 09, 13% of TMCC students are co-enrolled at another institution.
- Distance education accounted for 25% of the FTE in Spring 10.

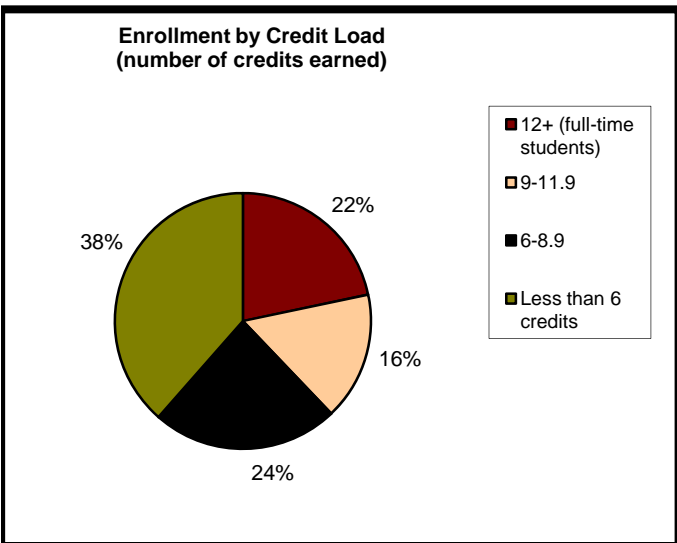

- In Spring 10, 30% of TMCC students are minorities, up from 25% in Spring 09.
- The percentage of students completing 12 or more credits in Spring 10 is up 3% from Spring 09 and up 6% from Spring 08.
- Approximately 22% of students are enrolled in 1 or more developmental course, which is about 2% more than the spring 09 and 3% more than spring 08. Developmental education accounts for 10% of the total FTE in Spring 10.
