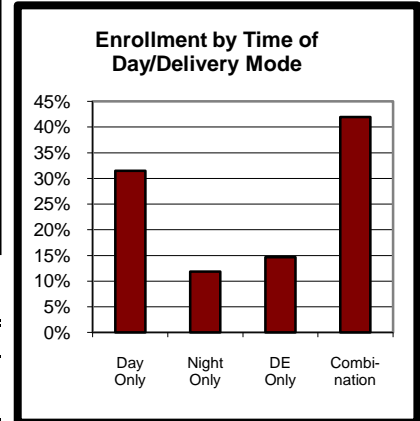

- State supported FTE in Spring 11 dropped by 2.8%, and headcount decreased by approximately 1% (compared to Spring 10).

- Distance education accounted for 22% of the FTE in Spring 11, which is down 3% from Spring 10.



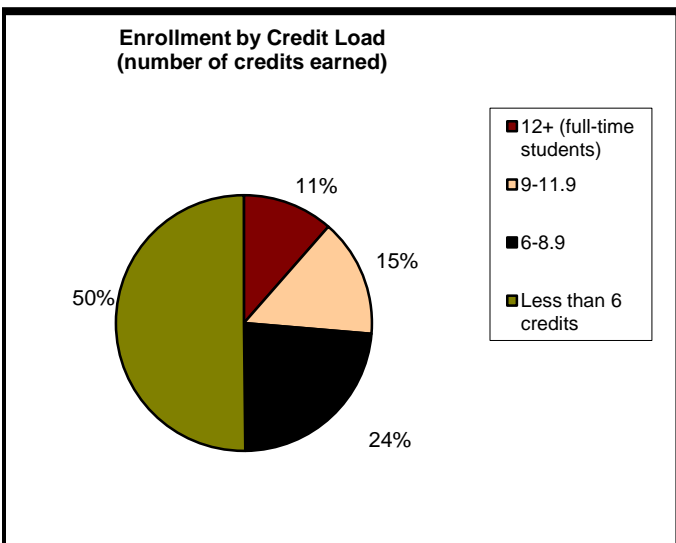

- In Spring 11, 32.5% of TMCC students are minorities, up from 30% in Spring 10.

- Approximately 37% of students are enrolled in 1 or more web-based course, which has dropped by 5% since Spring 10.

- In Spring 11, 50% of students earned less than 6 credits, which is up from 46% in Spring 10.
