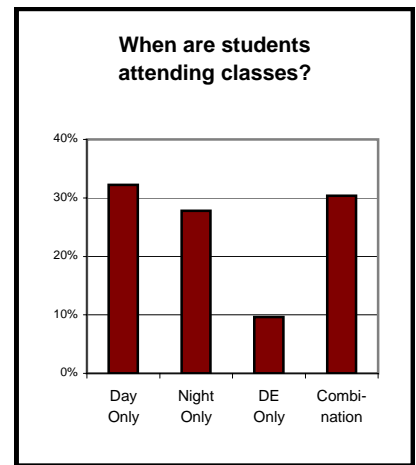

- The Fall 2004 state supported FTE of 5,953 represents a 7.5% increase from Fall 2003.

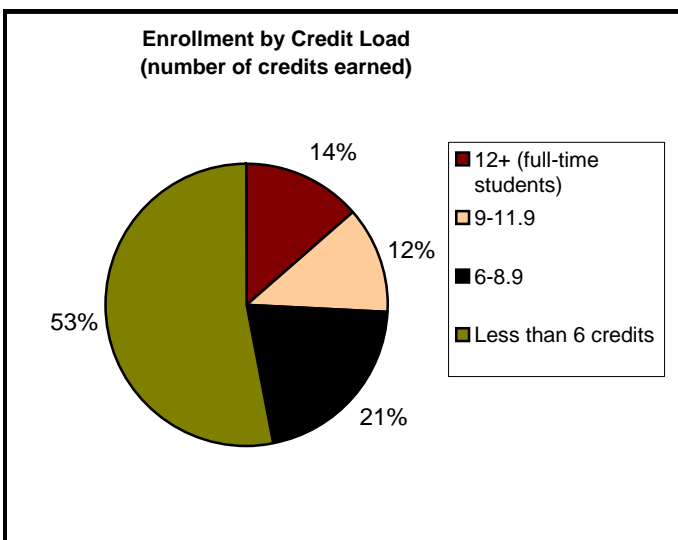

- 56% of students in Fall 2004 are female.

- 19% of students are enrolled in one or more developmental course compared to 18% in Fall 2003.

- Transfer/Gen. Ed courses make up 56% of Fall 2004 FTE, Vocational courses 35%, and Developmental courses 10%.

- In Fall 2004, 21.4% of TMCC students are minorities with Hispanics growing at a higher rate than any other ethnic group (15% since Fall 2003).
