



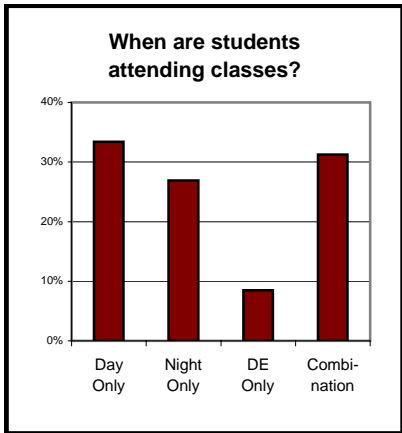

- The Spring 04 state supported FTE of 5,490 represents a 6% increase since Spring 03.

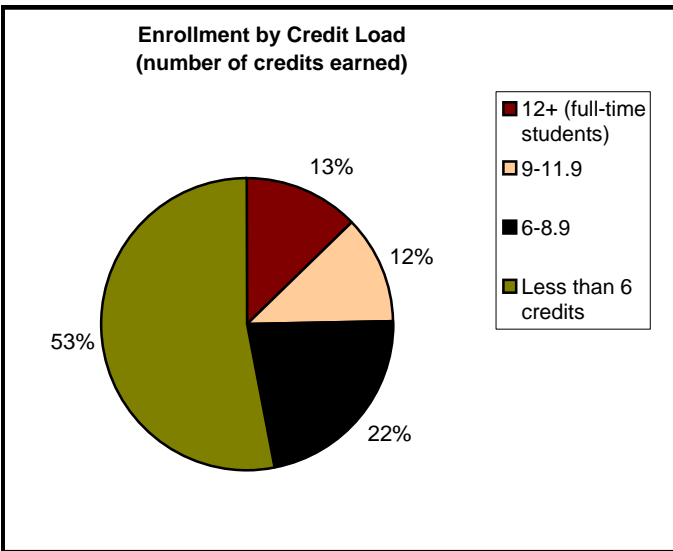

- In Spring 2004, 20% of TMCC students are minorities. 10.2% of TMCC students, or more than half of the minority students, are Hispanic, representing a 2% increase in Hispanic students from Fall 2003.
- 50% of students are ages 18-24. The largest percent change was in the 0-17 age category which dropped from 6.2% in Fall 03 to 1.6% in Spring 04.
- The percent of FTE attributed to transfer/gen ed courses increased to 57% (up 1% from Spr 03), and the percent attributed to vocational courses decreased by 1% from Spr 03.
