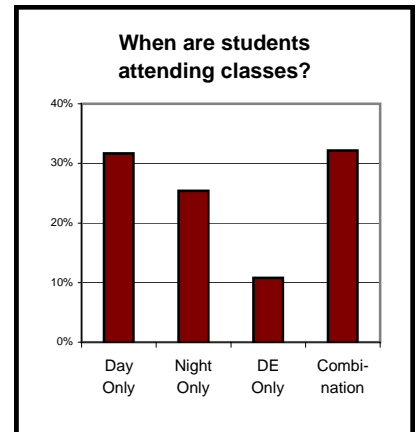

The Spring 05 FTE of 5,715 represents a 4.1% increase from Spring 04 while the headcount of 11,365 represents only a 1.6% increase for the same time period. This can be attributed to a continuous trend of growth in full-time enrollments (14% up from 13% in Spring 04).

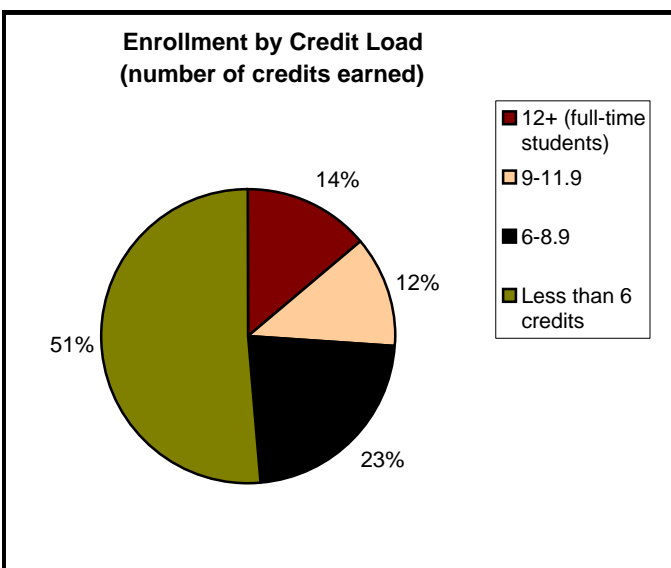

- 54% of all TMCC students are under the age of 25, a 3% increase from Spring 04.
- 11% of students are enrolled only in Distance Education classes, up from 8% last spring.
- In Spring 05, Hispanics (10.7%) are the only ethnic minority to increase (up from 10.2% in Spring 04).
- The percent of students with the goal of earning a degree went from 70% last spring to 72.3% in Spring 05.
