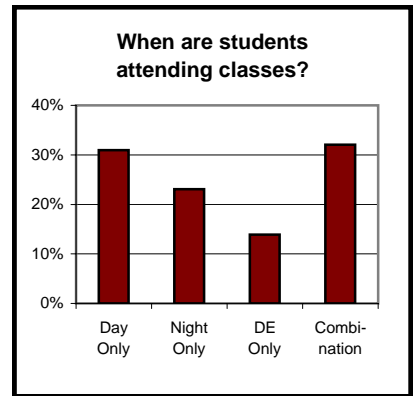

- In Spring 06, 14% of TMCC students are co-enrolled at another institution, up from 12% in Spring 05.

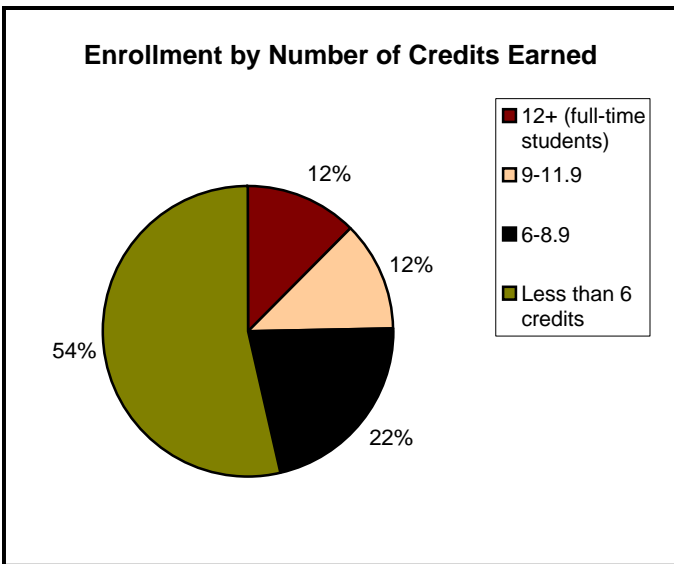

- In Spring 06, 22% of TMCC students are minorities, and 30% of Washoe County residents are minorities.
- The percentage of Hispanic students at TMCC has doubled in the last 10 years.
- The percentage of students enrolled only in Distance Education is at its highest level, 14%.
- Approximately 17% of students are enrolled in 1 or more developmental course, remaining consistent with the previous 2 Spring semesters.
