

Graduate Follow-up Survey

INTRODUCTION

A one-year follow-up survey was distributed to TMCC students receiving associate degrees or certificates achievement in the 2000-01 academic year. The goal of this survey is to gain insight regarding graduates' opinions of TMCC, their employment status and location, as well as the degree to which students attribute the attainment of their job and/or advancements within an occupation to the education they received at the College. Results of this survey also contribute to the measurement of Perkins III Core Performance Indicators.

METHODOLOGY

Population: The target population of this study was all TMCC graduates from the 2000-01 academic year. This cohort was comprised of 464 graduates. From this group of students, 81 useable surveys were returned, producing a 17% response rate.

Instrumentation and Procedure: The survey was designed as a single flyer that could be folded in reverse for returning mailing. The population was offered a five-dollar coupon at Raley's Supermarket for the return of the survey. This is an annual survey that is mailed out during the summer term each year.
