Example: Using the Reference Titles

Click on **Multicultural Studies**.

From the title list click on **Gale Encyclopedia of Multicultural America**.

Type **Chinese** in the Find Box.

Search exclusively within this publication by placing a check mark in the **Within This Publication** box. Click Search.

Click on the entry: **Chinese Americans**.
