

## ADMISSION PROCEDURES FOR THE TRADITIONAL NURSING PROGRAM - FALL 2010 ADMISSIONS

The following admission criteria will be used to select the class applying for admission for the fall semester 2010.

### Criteria

- **GPA 2.75 minimum, for all transferable lower division courses.**
    - If you believe you have special circumstances affecting your GPA, please see the director of nursing, <http://nursing.tmcc.edu>.
  - **Science GPA 3.0 average for BIOL 223, 224, 251 or their equivalent.**
    - The pre-requisite biology courses may be taken a maximum of two (2) times within the previous five (5) years. The highest grade of the first two times will be included in the calculation of overall and science GPA. The two attempts will be counted AFTER July, 2008.
  - **HESI A2 Admission Assessment Scores**
    - 75% minimum in biology, anatomy and physiology and math sections
- AND
- 75% average in grammar, reading comprehension, and vocabulary sections
    - § Learning Styles and Personality Inventory sections are taken, but not scored. The number of tests administered may vary from year to year.

### Deadlines

1. **Application** form **due Jan. 15, 2010 to RDMT 417 by 5 p.m.**
2. **HESI A2 Admission Assessment** test by **Jan. 15, 2010.**
  - a. HESI testing dates will be scheduled during the month of December and January. Register through the testing center at TMCC.
3. **Pre-requisite courses** (BIOL 223, 224, 251 and MATH 120 or 126).
  - a. Must be completed by the **end of fall semester 2009.**
4. **Transcripts** from all previous college work.
  - a. Transcripts from **all previous college work by Jan. 15, 2010**

### Point-Based Admission Selection

- **50% HESI A2 Admission Assessment Test Scores,**
- **50% GPA**
  - HESI Points-average percent score for the HESI A2 Admission Assessment Test is divided by the number 25.
  - GPA points 2.75 to a maximum of 4.0.
  - Example
    - Average of 85% on all HESI tests/25 = 3.4.
    - Overall GPA of 3.4
    - Total points awarded for admission would be 6.8 of a possible 8.0.

Students will be ranked by descending order, admission being offered to those ranking higher first.

### Nevada Residents

Qualified Bona fide\* Nevada residents and good neighbors who meet criteria listed in the college catalog are considered first for admission to the nursing program. Non-residents are considered after all available openings have been filled by Nevada residents and good neighbors.

#### \*Bona Fide Residence in Nevada

The student, or the parents or legal guardians of the student, must have continuous physical presence as a Nevada resident for at least twelve (12) months immediately prior to the date of application.
