
HESI TEST DATES FOR 2010 APPLICANTS TRADITIONAL PROGRAM

All applicants to the Truckee Meadows Community College traditional nursing program are required to take the Health Education Systems, Inc. (HESI) A2 Admission Assessment as a part of the application process for the RN program. HESI is a computerized test. Test takers should allow approximately six (6) hours to complete the examination.

FEE — The fee for the HESI assessment is \$50 payable at the TMCC Controller's Office, Red Mountain Building, room 318. The \$50 fee covers the required sections of the HESI Admission Assessment™ (A²).

LOCATION — The HESI Admission Assessment™ (A²) is administered by the TMCC Testing Center, Red Mountain Building, room 121; <http://testing.tmcc.edu>.

SCHEDULING THE TEST — *Pre-registration is required.* Please go to the testing center on the TMCC Dandini Campus, located in the Red Mountain Building, room 121. All students must show proof of payment for testing in order to schedule an appointment.

Dates and times for Spring 2010 traditional program applicants only:

Saturdays, Dec. 19, 2009 and Jan. 9, 2010

Exam begins at 9 a.m. and last until approximately 3 p.m.

Monday to Friday, Nov. 19 to Dec. 18

Exam begins at 9 a.m. and last until approximately 3 p.m.

Testing Day Procedures

- 1 – Arrive **30 minutes prior** to the start of the test to check-in.
- 2 – If you arrive after the published test start time you **will not** be permitted to test and will need to sign up for a different test date.
- 3 – You **must** bring a current government-issued photo ID (drivers license, passport, military ID, etc.) to be admitted to the test.
- 4 – Two **15-minute breaks** will be provided. We recommend you bring snacks and water to the test since vending options are limited. There will be no lunch/dinner break.
