

HIGHLIGHTS

- >> State supported FTE decreased by 2% and headcount decreased by 1% compared to Fall 13 end of term.
- >> The number of students exclusively enrolled in distance education courses increased 8% since Fall 2013.
- » 37% of TMCC students are minorities, up from 36% in Fall 2013.
- >> 19% of students are enrolled in 1 or more developmental course, down from 21% in Fall 2013.
- The degree-seeking population continues to decrease, down by 4% from Fall 2013. The number of students with a goal of earning a degree at TMCC has declined 13% since Fall 2012.
