


# PROGRAM/UNIT REVIEW (PUR)

## Accessing PURs In eLumen For ASA Member Review

1. [Login to eLumen](#) with your TMCC username and password. Use Chrome or Firefox as your browser.
2. Select "ASA Committee Member" as your role from the drop-down menu, then select the "Strategic Planning" toolbar.
3. Select a PUR, e.g. Graphic Communications, from the drop-down menu next to the "ASA Committee Member" role. If the same PUR doesn't appear under Organization, select it there too.
4. Click on the blue link (not the checkbox) under Name to open the PUR self-study.
