# 8. Matters that concern Classified Staff

• Everyone should know that if a bargaining unit (defined in the link below) is certified (51% or more of the employees are AFSCME members state-wide), those employees will receive a 3% increase in wages in FY23. The employees who work in an uncertified bargaining unit (less than 51% of the employees are AFSCME members state-wide) will only receive a 1% raise.

This is the first time our union AFSCME cannot represent all employees equally whether or not the employee is an active member. Please check out the email below from Harry Shiffman regarding AB493.

The following bargaining units (link below) have not met the minimum 51% of employees as active duespaying AFSCME members, so these employees will only receive a 1% raise in FY23. I have not heard how the negotiations for FY22 will work. The Administrative Clerical (B: pages 9-10), Technical Aides and Professionals (C: Pages 11-15), Supervisory Employees (J: pages 16-25), and Confidential employees (page 41).

The dues cost 1% of your gross wages, balanced with our union negotiating benefits for the employees. For example, we suffered only six months of furloughs (half of what was approved) in FY21 because AFSCME helped the State of Nevada bring in additional funding through the Cares and Heros Acts.
