

LONGITUDINAL ASSESSMENT PLAN

Introduction

The English Department is committed to ongoing and practical assessment of our offerings as a means to deliver quality education to the students who take our courses. We see assessment as a natural part of what we do as teachers. We also see assessment as a cycle that should allow for time to collect data, collate it and analyze it. The results of the data analysis, when indicated, should lead to improved teaching pedagogies and strategies being implemented in our courses , but these strategies will require time before showing any results. Because of this, we have established multi-year assessment cycles for all the courses in the department. All of our regularly taught courses will follow a three year cycle, the minimum for an effective assessment cycle. Courses that are not offered regularly will be assessed as offered. All assessments will come from department faculty and be conducted by department faculty. The cycles have been arranged so as not to overburden faculty with assessment activities, while giving each one a more viable impact.

This plan outlines the cycles and time frames for assessment in the English Department starting from Fall 2011. It leaves open what vehicles may be used for assessment to allow faculty expertise to be the guiding force for assessment vehicle development.

Collection of assessment vehicles will take place at the end of the semester noted in the schedules below. Assessment reads will take place during Spring Professional Development Days for essays collected in the Fall, and during contract days after Spring Semester for essays collected in the Spring. Assessment analysis activities will take place over the summer or during Fall Professional Development Days. The faculty responsible for the assessment results will present their findings at the first department meeting in the Fall of the year following the assessment collection activities. Plans for improving any areas in need of remediation will be discussed and implemented for the two years before the next assessment vehicle collection. Course Assessment Reports (CARs) will be filed by December 1st of that same year.

In sum, the three year cycle will collect, collate and analyze data in the first year. The second year focus will be on implementing any pedagogical changes indicated by the assessment data. The third year will continue perfecting any pedagogical changes required. These two years of working on the issues indicated in the assessment should result in improved numbers when the cycle starts over again. If not, pedagogical changes will be made to address the new results.

In some cases, the three year cycle will miss courses that are not offered during the cycle period. Courses that are not taught on a regular basis or become irregular in their offering because of scheduling or lack of enrollment will be assessed whenever they are taught successfully by the faculty teaching the course.

In general, the course assessment cycles are meant to allow faculty to be effective in their assessments by focusing assessment activities so as to spread out the burden among all faculty. The schedules below are designed to allow faculty to choose an assessment focus each year that fits in with the courses they teach on a regular basis. Course types have been grouped to allow for this.

Composition Sequences

Assessment vehicles are developed by the committees governing these courses. ENG 098 is handled by the Developmental Committee. ENG 101 and ENG 102 are handled by the Composition Committee. ESL courses, ENG 112, 113 and 114, are developed by the ESL committee. The ESL composition courses will be assessed in the same school year as the freshman composition course to which it corresponds. Freshman composition assessment collection will be performed in the Fall semester of that year, while the ESL composition assessment collection will take place in the Spring semester. The schedule for assessment collection follows.

Developmental Learning Community

Assessment vehicles will be developed by the Pre Committee. Assessment should cover both classes at once so that the community effort is assessed. The cycle is similar to the regular composition cycle and takes into account both reading skills and writing improvement.

Portfolios or creative final pieces will be collected from these courses whenever they are offered held until the first year of the assessment schedule. Questions posed of these pieces will be developed by a task force of faculty who regularly teach creative writing courses, and should be general enough to encompass any type of creative writing. Creative Writing Faculty may choose to divide the assessment into two separate assessments: poetic forms and prose forms. This will ensure that any assessment questions or rubrics can successfully measure learning outcomes in the different courses. Courses in this group that are not taught on a regular basis will gather assessment materials whenever taught and then assess those in the next cycle listed below.
