To approve the wording: Courses used for AA/AS general education are eligible to meet the BAS Bachelor's Gen Ed requirements. AAS general education classes may not be used to satisfy the Gen Ed for BAS Bachelor's degrees if they are nontransferable.

Total # of Credits for the BAS Bachelor's degree....120 credits.

At TMCC students will be required to complete 120 credits to earn a BAS Bachelor's degree. Students will earn a total of 32 credits at TMCC including UD and LD selections. Students are required to earn 40 UD credits for the Bachelor's degree.
