- > TMCC has made great headway on OER efforts. Two degrees are now 100% OER; AA and AS General Transfer degrees.
- ➤ President Hilgersom is hopeful for a positive legislative session. Governor Lombardo has hit the ground running and is doing things a bit differently than over Governors have. One

thing specifically was to convene a special committee to discuss K12 and higher education. The committee met several times over the last month or so and the meetings have led to more collaborative input and efforts in relation to education, what is working and what is not, and President Hilgersom feels that Governor Lombardo is listening.

A few new employees were mentioned: Devin in the President's office has assumed the role Valerie Kelley used to serve. Two full time Librarians have started (Maggie and Laurel), MCO has a new social media expert (Barrie), and Olga Mesina is stepping away from DRC and will now be TMCC's full time mental health professional. With higher student mental health concerns, this could not come at a better time.
