<p><b>Syllabus</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> The course syllabus is in an electronic and accessible format prior to the start of class, ideally prior to the opening of the registration period for the course.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>and</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> The course syllabus includes a statement regarding support for students with disabilities.</p>
<p><b>Video and Audio</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Video or audio content to be shown in class or accessed online is closed captioned and/or transcribed.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>or</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> A plan has been established to provide an equal alternate form of access to video or audio content that is not captioned or transcribed.</p>
<p><b>Print Materials</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Textbook requisitions are sent to the bookstore by established deadlines.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>or</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> A plan has been established to ensure access to an equal alternate form of print materials is available the first day of class.</p>
<p><b>Course Readers/Course Packs</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> An accessible electronic version of the course reader or written material is available on the first day of class.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>or</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> A plan has been established to provide an equal alternate form of access on the first day of class.</p>
<p><b>Library and Outside Content</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Library materials, third-party content and learning management systems for the course have been checked to ensure they can be accessed by users of assistive technology.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>or</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> A plan has been established to provide an equal alternate form of access to the content.</p>
<p><b>Handouts Distributed Online/Print</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Course materials created in Microsoft Word, PowerPoint and Adobe Acrobat PDF are accessible.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>or</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> A plan has been established to provide an equal alternate form of access.</p>
