Approve minutes from February 08, 2019

WebCollege Updates

Chair Dan Hooper opened up the meeting to review analytical data provided by Brandy Scarnati. The data showed the percentage of published courses in Canvas, what page students access most in a course, and a comparison of Canvas use from last year to present. Canvas use is steadily on the incline.

A Discussion was presented relating to this on the most used course menu items for ease of student navigation. It was discussed that the committee should come up with a best practice for course navigation and later present this to other faculty.

TMCC Data

Natalie Fisher presented information to the committee about how TMCC ranks on a national level using data provided in the last legislative email from Marketing. The national graduation rate for community colleges is 23.6% and TMCC has a graduation rate of 31.5%.
