SELECTIVE SERVICE APPEAL

Federal regulations require that male U.S. citizens and male aliens living in the U.S. born after December Dec. 31, 1959, are required to register with the Selective Service. Males who are not registered with the Selective Service will not qualify for federal financial aid programs.

Instructions: If you did not register with the Selective Service you may complete this form and provide as much documentation as possible to prove that your failure to register was not knowing and willful. **You must attach a letter from the Selective Service stating your Selective Service status.** You may request the letter at www.sss.gov.
