AI Professional Development Update:

- Fred gave an update on Guest Speaker, Reed Dickson, trainings scheduled for Jan 16. Reed is a Community College specialist in AI. Sessions are part of professional development and will include Q&A for engagement.
- There are two sessions that faculty and staff may attend. 'The AI Ready College: A TMCC Keynote' @ 10:00 a.m. and 'What Educators Need to Know About Generative AI in 2024: a TMCC Faculty Workshop' @ 2:30 p.m.
- Luncheon and Leadership session to be finalized. Meeting invites will go out to key constituents, cabinet and deans.

Technology Surveys Update:

- Faculty survey goes out on Monday and ends on 1/22; Student survey goes out on 1/29 and ends on 2/12
- Staff survey went out in December and we have the results.
- Tech Support: 72% Excellent and 21% Good (9 people said Fair, and 1 said Poor).
- Understanding of AI: 80% said Some, Good, Expert and 20% said Limited or None.
- Open-ended questions were answered by 133 respondents and skipped by only 17. We had outstanding results with these open-ended questions. The number of respondents that answered is extremely high compared to a typical survey.

Workgroup Updates:

- Workgroups should have results to share by March.
- Kyle and Cheryl will be reviewing all survey results. A summary of the results comparison with actionable takeaways is projected for March.

Spring Training/Demo sessions – Vivi:
