1. Updates

- b. The committee planned to have a small focus group interview consisting of smokers / veterans to assess their thoughts about adopting a tobacco-free campus policy. Participants will freely express their thoughts and opinions to the assigned questions regarding the tobacco-free policy.
- c. The Tobacco-Free committee will collaborate with the Wellness Committee and Facility department to plan a walking path project, such as providing exercise equipment along the walking path.
- d. The committee will discuss with Nicole Shimabuku to host a tobacco prevention presentation for SGA new students in the upcoming semester.

3. Marketing

- a. Patricia and marketing intern will help design the tobacco cessation cards to give out to campus members.
- b. In order to increase campus awareness of designated smoking areas and a healthy campus, efforts to install more no-smoking signs around campuses will be made.
