

MEETING MINUTES

November 1, 2018

1. Updates

- a. Hallie Madole, Tobacco-Free Committee Chair met with President Hilgersom in regards passing the resolution to move forward to become a tobacco-free campus. This is the first time TMCC passing a resolution; therefore, the committee needs to get a vote from both SGA and Faculty Senate.
- b. The Tobacco-Free Committee presented to SGA students on October 24 about the benefits of having a tobacco-free campus policy and briefly mentioned about the resolution. SGA students will be voting on the resolution on November 14.
- c. Hallie Madole presented the resolution at the Faculty Senate meeting on November 2. There were some questions in terms of clarification of the Nevada Clean Indoor Air Act (NRS 202.2483) and a list of nicotine products. Email follow-up was sent to individuals who are well versed in NRS to interpret this statute.

2. Discussion items

- a. Great American Smokeout will be on November 14 from 11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. at the student center at Dandini campus. Jordan Thomas has recruited eight EMT students to help table at the event.

- c. Social media campaign will start next Spring 2019 to help gain awareness about the health effects of tobacco products and efforts to build a healthy campus.
- d. Hallie reached out to Brandy Davis to reconnect with marketing department after Patricia left. It is crucial to have a marketing representative in our committee to help post regular educational messages on TMCC's FB page.
